

Postdoctoral Fellowship in "Psychology & Medicine: Translational Research on Stress, Behavior and Disease"

The University of California, San Francisco offers a two-year NIMH-funded postdoctoral fellowship for research training in the relationship of mental and physical health. Fellows have a focus either on (1) health-risk behaviors especially those leading to HIV/AIDS (theories of risk, developmental processes, decision-making, behavior change), or on (2) stress, depression, psychobiology and disease (e.g., social context of stress, cognitive appraisal, psychophysiological responses). Women and minorities are encouraged to apply. The program is open to PhDs and MDs. Apply by February 1st to begin by Fall 2010.
